**Chester County Commissioners approve distribution
of \$5.4 million in Community Revitalization Program funds**
Eleven county municipalities receive money for projects

WEST CHESTER _ The Chester County Commissioners approved today the distribution of \$5.4 million in Community Revitalization Program funds to 11 county municipalities.

The awards included money for streetscape improvements to Parkesburg and West Grove, each \$600,000, \$331,374 to Malvern, \$749,668 to Elverson and \$546,530 to West Chester.

Atglen received \$255,944 for street, curb, sidewalk and storm water work; Honey Brook received \$338,286 for water main installation; Downingtown received \$662,552 for bridge construction; Modena received \$165,646 for street reconstruction; Phoenixville received \$450,000 for replacement of sanitary sewer intercept; and Coatesville received \$700,000 for a parking lot construction.

“All of the projects are meaningful to the communities,” Patrick Bokovitz, Director Chester County Department of Community Development, said. “The Coatesville project is in connection with the revitalization of the city’s train station and the Downingtown money is being used to connect residents to the renovated mill that contains a new restaurant.”

The Department of Community Development administers the programs for the county.
