Fair Housing: A Time to Act

Does your agency serve the classes protected under the Fair Housing Act? Have you worked with a client that may have experienced housing discrimination and were unsure how to help? This workshop will present the basics of the Fair Housing Act, and describe who is protected under this law. Learn how to recognize signs of housing discrimination, gain resources for helping clients who may experience unlawful housing discrimination, and give them tools to exercise their housing rights.

Who should attend? Any staff who work with consumers, and community members with all types of housing related services such as housing subsidies or financial assistance, landlord-tenant concerns, the condition and repair of housing, or housing placement for individuals and families. This workshop is also great for newly-hired employees or those who would like a refresher course on Fair Housing including program administrators, managers, leasing agents, clerical support, nurses and health care aides.
