## Proclamation


- WHEREAS:** Since 1970, millions of Americans have celebrated Earth Day annually as a campaign to protect the environment; and

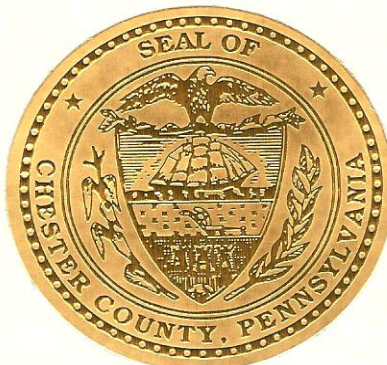


on April 22, 2011, in recognition of the vital contribution that thousands of Chester County citizens have made, and will continue to make, to further the evolution of environmental progress.


