

# CHESTER COUNTY PARKS AND RECREATION CAMPGROUNDS

## AT HIBERNIA COUNTY PARK- Park Office 610-383-3812

- Camping is permitted during the weekend of opening day of trout and then re opens the first full weekend in May through the last weekend of October, for Friday night, Saturday night, and holiday nights.
- Camping is first come, first serve. The only exception to this rule is for the weekend of the Chester County Old Fiddlers Picnic, held annually the second Saturday in August. Reservations for that one weekend may be made starting one month before the date of the event, and must be for both nights.

## CAMPGROUND RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Campsites are assigned in the order in which they are requested. Campers may switch sites **ONLY** with approval from the park office.
2. Overnight campsite occupancy is required during the entire period designated on the permit. Failure to maintain overnight occupancy of the campsite shall be construed as an abandonment of the Camping Permit, which will authorize removal of camping equipment and forfeiture of site. There are no refunds for campers who vacate their site early.
3. Campers must register by 8:00 PM and **checkout by 3:00 PM**. If staying for additional nights, campers must re-register by 12:00 noon.
4. Two camping units are permitted at each site, one of which must be a tent. Sleeping in personal vehicles is not considered camping and is not permitted.
5. **Maximum number of people per site is six**, including one responsible individual 18 years of age or older.
6. Two vehicles are permitted at each site, including guest vehicles. **Extra vehicles must park in designated parking areas.**
7. Trash: Campers are responsible to clean campsite and remove all garbage and litter. Trash can be placed in dumpsters at end of Campground Road (see map on reverse side).
8. Fires are permitted only in camp stoves or fire rings provided. Any fire must be attended at all times by someone 18 years of age or older. Fires must be extinguished completely before leaving campsite. Bonfires are prohibited. A fire ban may be in effect during dry weather.
9. The Park does NOT provide firewood. Cutting of standing trees is strictly prohibited. Only scavenge dead and downed wood.
10. Guests must register at the park office. Guests are permitted during park hours ONLY.
11. **Quiet hours are 10:00 PM – 8:00 AM**. No loud music, talking ect. Generators cannot be operated during quiet hours.
12. **One Picnic table is provided for each site. Tables are not to be moved to or from any site.**
13. Secure all valuables, including lanterns, coolers, etc. The DEPARTMENT is NOT responsible for losses of equipment.
14. A sanitary dump station is available for trailer campers (see map on reverse side).
15. **The following are prohibited:**
  - **Alcoholic beverages**
  - Dishwashing and/or bathing at water outlets, springs, or waterways.
  - Discharging trailer sewage or sink water on the ground or into surface water.
  - **Driving nails/hardware into trees**
  - Electric or water hook-ups
  - Chainsaws

Violation of any county rule or regulation or any misrepresentation by individuals using the areas and facilities for purposes other than that defined will warrant cancellation of permit, removal from the park, and /or legal action.
