**DIRECTIONS :**

**From Reading :** Take 422 East to Collegeville exit, Route 29. Follow Route 29 North (at Collegville Shopping Center watch for a right and quick left!) The next light you come to will be the intersection of Rt.113 and Rt.29. Make a right. Travel about 2 miles and look on your left for the 4-H center.

**From Allentown:** Take Route309 South to Souderton, Route 113 exit. Follow Route 113 west across Route 73. The 4-H center is located on Route 113 one mile past Route 73 on the right hand side.

**From Turnpike:** Exit at Valley Forge. Follow signs to Route 422 West. Follow to Collegeville exit, Route 29. Proceed as listed above in directions “From Reading”

**From Northeast Extension:** Exit at Kulpville. Turn right onto Rt 63 (Sumneytown Pike). Follow several miles to Route 113. Turn Left onto 113. Follow Route113 across Route 73. The 4-H Center is located on Route 113 one mile past Route 73 on the right hand side
