

## **Prevention Request for Proposals (RFP) Questions & Answers**

Question: does the proposed innovative program need to have met just one or both of the recognition criteria: (a) identified or recognized publicly, received awards, etc.; (b) appeared in a non-referenced professional publication. And, if so, how could we determine if the one national publication in which our program appeared would be considered acceptable?

Answer: The proposed program or program principle must meet both criteria described in the Request for Proposal (RFP). It is the applicant's responsibility to provide support/justification for this.
