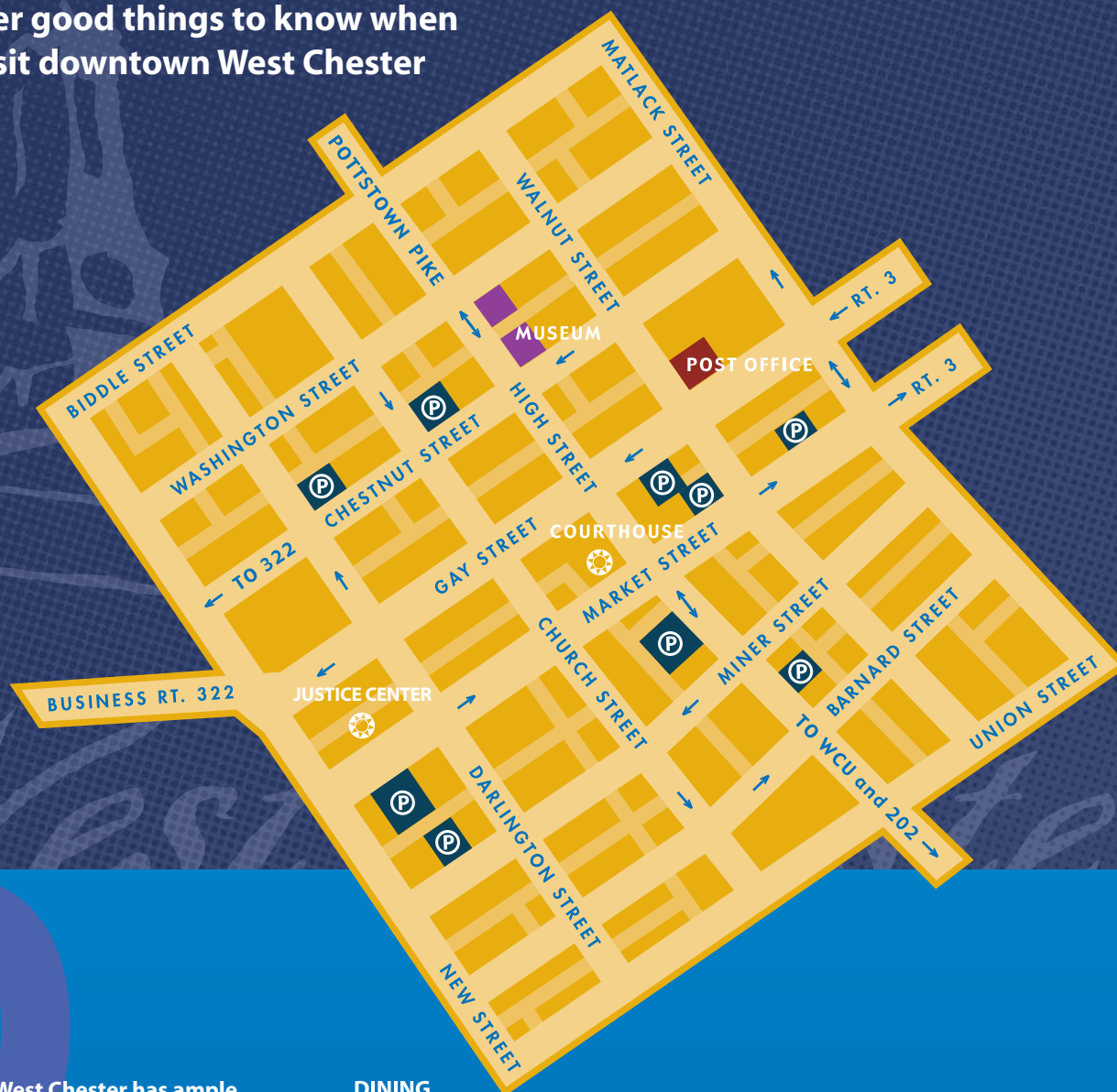


FREE Parking Weekends

and other good things to know when you visit downtown West Chester



Downtown West Chester has ample parking for visitors even during big events. Parking meters accept quarters only (up to eight) for two hours between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. On-street parking is free after 5 p.m. and on weekends and holidays.

Parking at the Bicentennial Garage (22 South High St, near Market) is good for worry-free browsing. It's free on the weekends except during the Restaurant Festival. And many merchants will validate your parking with a purchase.

The new Justice Center garage is now open on West Market near New Street. Metered parking is available on the second floor and is free after 5 p.m. and on all weekends and holidays.

DINING

Downtown West Chester is a dining destination with dozens of restaurants to choose from. Many offer outside dining during nice weather. On weekends, your favorite restaurant may be very busy, but most accept reservations. Many restaurants are BYOB. A complete restaurant guide can be found at DowntownWestChester.com.
