

## 2010 ANTLERLESS DEER LICENSE ISSUANCE SCHEDULE

Please note: qualified landowners apply directly to the appropriate County Treasurer for a landowner antlerless deer license at any time prior to license sales to the general public.

### First-Come-First-Served License Issuance

**Monday, July 12** - First day resident antlerless deer license applications accepted by County Treasurers. (Mail Only)

**Monday, July 26** - First day nonresident antlerless deer license applications accepted by County Treasurers. (Mail Only)

**Monday, August 2** – If antlerless deer licenses are still available, County Treasurers begin accepting antlerless deer license applications from residents and nonresidents for unsold tags. (Mail Only: first round, one unsold tag per applicant)

**Monday, August 2** - County Treasurers begin accepting antlerless deer license applications from residents and nonresidents for unlimited unsold tags in WMUs 2B, 5C and 5D only. (Mail only)

**Monday, August 16** – If antlerless deer licenses are still available, County Treasurers begin accepting antlerless deer license applications from residents and nonresidents for a second unsold tag. (Mail Only: second round, one additional unsold tag per applicant)

**Monday, August 23** – County Treasurers begin accepting WMU 2B, 5C and 5D applications over-the-counter from residents and nonresidents for unlimited unsold tags.

**Monday, September 13** – Deadline for County Treasurers to mail successful applicants' licenses (regular and first round unsold).

**Monday, September 27** – Deadline for County Treasurers to mail successful applicants' licenses (second round unsold).

### Over-the-Counter Sales: Statewide

**Monday, October 4** – County Treasurers statewide begin accepting applications over-the-counter if antlerless deer licenses and unsold tags are still available.
